Dr Sushil Kumar Kansal, Associate Professor, University Institute of Chemical Engineering and Technology, Panjab University has recently visited University of Waterloo, Waterloo, Canada for four weeks in November, 2012 under Faculty Mobility Program of Shastri Indo-Canadian Institute. This is a highly prestigious fellowship and this year, this fellowship has been awarded to only two teachers from India.
